Reef Extension Program

The only criteria for participation is that you must have completed your BMP Self-assessment checklist and that this identifies an opportunity to improve your on-farm nutrient and soil management practices.

Thanks to the Commonwealth Government funding, the Australian Banana Growers' Council (ABGC) can offer growers through REP:

- small group or individual extension services
- access to grants
- the chance to run innovation trials to validate "cutting edge" practices





The banana industry also has access to the BetterBunch app – a new approach to electronic record keeping.

Like REP, access to the BetterBunch app is free and available upon the completion of your BMP checklist.

The REP will use the BMP checklist and the BetterBunch app to help improve Reef water quality and boost productivity.
