

SEDIMENT MANAGEMENT PLANNING WORKSHOP

Workshops to be held in
April, May & June 2018

If you're in need of help in developing a sediment management plan for your farm, this workshop is the one for you.

This half day workshop will help develop a personalised sediment plan for your own farm with expert assistance.

Farm and topographic maps of your property will be provided along with materials on how to implement sediment control structures such as contouring, diversion banks and sediment traps that assist in the retention of your soil.

Following the workshop, you will be eligible for a FREE one-on-one site visit with a

soil conservation expert who can provide technical advice on implementation of on-farm works specific to your property.

By attending this workshop, you will be eligible to apply for incentive grant funding to assist in the implementation of sediment works following the workshop. This funding is only available to workshop participants.

The workshop will run for 3 hours with morning tea and lunch provided.
