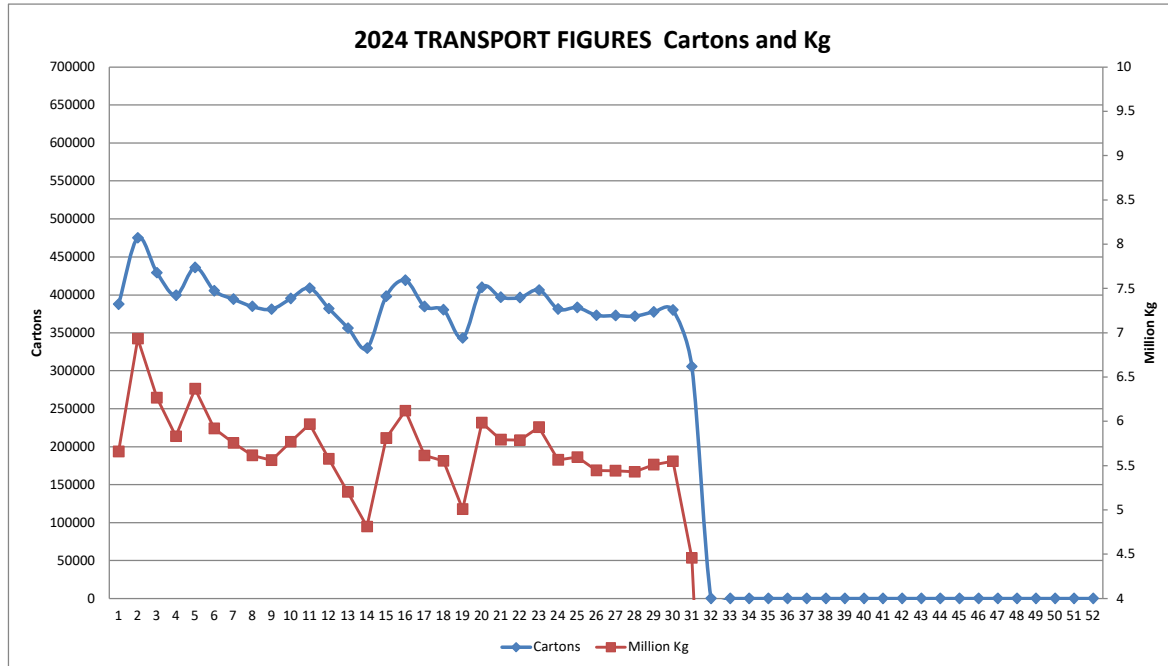
NOTE: ABGC has converted the carton numbers to kilograms by using the current estimate of the proportion of 15kg cartons used in NQ. I.e. 80% 15kg cartons / 20% 13kg cartons. Consequently, the kilogram figures and the chart of them, has been constructed by converting carton numbers advised by transport operators to kilograms by assuming 80% (instead of 70%) are 15kg. You will see from the chart that we have made this change effective from 1 January 2019.

The chart displays monthly transport figures in cartons for five years: 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024. The Y-axis represents the number of cartons, ranging from 0 to 700,000 in increments of 50,000. The X-axis represents months from 1 to 52. The data series are as follows:

- 2020 (Orange line with diamond markers):** Shows a peak of approximately 550,000 cartons in month 2, followed by a decline and then a steady increase, peaking again at around 520,000 in month 44 before a slight drop.
- 2021 (Blue line with diamond markers):** Starts around 450,000, peaks at 550,000 in month 41, and then shows a significant drop to near zero around month 32, remaining low thereafter.
- 2022 (Green line with triangle markers):** Fluctuates between 350,000 and 500,000 cartons throughout the year, with a notable peak of over 500,000 in month 48.
- 2023 (Red line with square markers):** Shows a general upward trend, starting around 380,000 and peaking at approximately 520,000 in month 49, before a sharp decline.
- 2024 (Light blue line with asterisk markers):** This series is only visible in the first 31 months, peaking at around 400,000 in month 16 and then declining.
